Certificate of Adult training (CoAL)

Appropriate (VET) current First Aid Certificate

Common Core Level 1 basic training is required for all Adventurous Scout Activities Training.

This may be achieved in the sail training or through another activity training program, e.g. bushwalking, caving, canoeing
