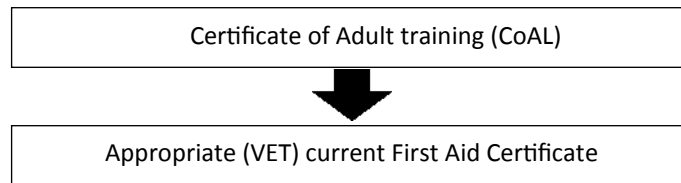


# Adventurous Scout Activities

### Training Flowchart For Canoe or Kayak



**Common Core Level 1 basic training is required for all Adventurous Scout Activities Training.**  
*This may be achieved in the canoe/kayak training or through another activity training program, e.g. bushwalking, caving*

To undertake your Canoeing/Kayaking training you will then need to progress to a specific skill set. The base level for supervising qualifications, for Canoeing and Kayaking is Level 2. Level 1 Canoeing or Kayaking is not an endorsement to be in charge of Scout members on the water.
